MEMORANDM TO: CLUB AND RANGE EXECUTIVE

SUBJECT: *An Act to Amend Certain Acts and Regulations in Relation to Firearms (former Bill C-71) - Implications on Authorizations to Transport (ATT)*

The *An Act to Amend Certain Acts and Regulations in Relation to Firearms* requires licenced owners of registered firearms to contact the Chief Firearms Office of jurisdiction [Ontario] to **obtain an ATT** to transport a restricted or prohibited firearm to:

1. a gun show;
2. to or from a Canadian port of entry or exit;
3. to a peace officer or CFO for verification or disposal;
4. for sale, appraisal, export, or repair; or
5. for any other purpose.

Authorizations to transport firearms to and from a range within your province of residence will continue to be automatically granted for restricted firearms and certain prohibited handguns, if a CFO approved these firearms as acquired for the purpose of target shooting.

The following **two provisions remain as conditions on a firearms licence**, and are valid within the holder's province of residence:

1. To and from a section 29 approved shooting range; and
2. To transport a newly acquired firearm
