Steps to Becoming a Member

- 2) Take the club level Range Safety Officer and Orientation Program.
- 3) Attend the General Meeting for membership approval. Meeting takes place 2nd Thursday of the Month.
- 4) If you have restricted status you will need to complete the Gun Level Restricted Safety Program.
- 5) If you have restricted status you will need to complete a series of Probationary Shoots.
- 6) Fulfill your club obligations by participating in fund raising projects.
- 7) Attend at least one Perch dinner per year.
- 8) Attend at least one General Meeting per year after membership is approved.
